1st Interviews- online

2nd Interviews – on-site

Before the 2nd interview, you will be asked to complete the Personality Questionnaire. For some programs you may be asked to prepare a short presentation, a case study, or a task.

Tip: Be honest with your answers to the questionnaire. Try to stick to the time and topic of the presentation – sometimes it's better to make it simple but straight to the point 😊
